


CHOCOLATE DIRT PUDDING CUPS WITH GUMMY WORMS

ORGANIZE INGREDIENTS AND UTENSILS

Ingredients, for the chocolate pudding:

- 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 5 tablespoons granulated sugar
- 2 tablespoons cocoa powder
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 1 ¼ cups milk
- 2 large eggs
- 1 ¼ cups semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract



Ingredients, for the worm pudding cups:

- 1 15-oz. package chocolate sandwich cookies (like Oreos)
- 8-oz. whipping cream (very cold)
- 24 gummy worms
- 8 plastic cups

Utensils:

- heavy bottom medium size saucepan
- whisk
- 1 medium bowl, and 1 large bowl and ice, for ice bath
- plastic wrap
- ziplock bag and rolling pin, or food processor
- hand mixer
- 12 plastic cups

INSTRUCTIONS, FOR THE PUDDING:

- 1. The first step is to make the dirt. Place the chocolate sandwich cookies in a large zip-top plastic bag, and use a rolling-pin to crush them into small pieces.
- 2. Continue to crush the cookies in the bag until they are in fine crumbs. You can use a food processor for this step.
- 3. Using your hand mixer, whip 8-oz. of whipping cream until it thickens.
- 4. Grab your previously prepared pudding, and add the whipped cream and approximately half of the cookie crumbs.
- 5. Gently stir everything together until everything is well combined.
- 6. Divide the pudding mixture evenly between eight cups—each should hold a little over ½-cup of pudding.
- 7. Tap the cups on the counter top a few times to level the pudding, then insert 3 gummy worms.
- 8. Pour the cookie crumbs over the pudding and gummy worms so that the entire top is covered with dirt.

INSTRUCTIONS, TO ASSEMBLE THE DIRT PUDDING CUPS:

- 8. 8 Pour the cookie crumbs over the pudding and gummy worms so that the entire top is covered with dirt.
